There can be no better place to work during this festive season than in a primary school – the child in us all comes to the fore!

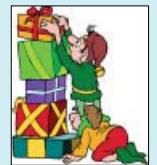
I wish you all a lovely weekend and hope you manage to get all your shopping done on time – only 15 days to go!!!!!!!!!!!!
