The Earth and everything on it.

Continent

A large area of land (Asia, Africa, North/South America, Oceania, Europe, Antarctica)

Ocean

A large body of water that separates the continents. There are 5 in total.

Equator

An imaginary line that splits the world in half into hemispheres.

Hemisphere

The name given to each half of the Earth (North and South).

South Pole

The name given to the very bottom of the Earth.

North Pole

The name given to the very top of the Earth.

Country

An area of land controlled by a group of people.

Landmark

A famous place in a country.



We are learning to:

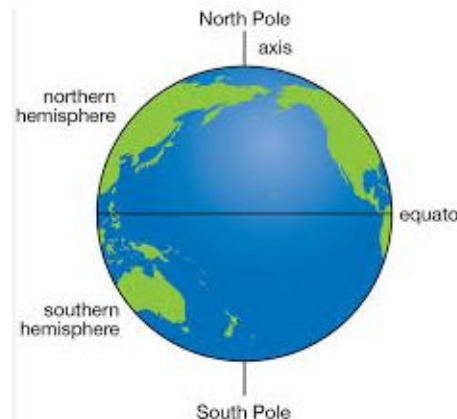
- Name and locate the world's seven continents and five oceans.
