The point at which the land meets the sea. **Beach**

A narrow strip of land that sits on a coastline. Cliff

A landform of rock that rises straight up from the ground.

Sand dunes

A mound of sand formed by the wind blowing.

Bav

A small body of water on a coastline.

Harbour

A small body of water protected from ocean/sea.

Pier

A raised area over a body of water.

Tourism

The movement of people to a particular place.

Port

A place for boats to dock.

Ocean

A large body of water and one of the 5 oceans of the world

Sea

A body of water that is smaller than an ocean.
