Agriculture

Land used for farming or growing crops.

Residential

Land used for housing for people to live in.

Industrial

Land used for factories and warehouses.

Comercial

Land used for shops for being to buy things.

Transport

Land used for roads or railways.

Rural

An area dominated by countryside and fields.

Urbar

An area dominated by large houses or buildings.

About 90% of the land in the UK is rural!


