Aariculture

Archaeologist

a person who learns about the past by digging up and studying previously used objects

Artefact

any object made by human beings, especially one of an earlier era

BC/BCF

before Christ/Before Common Era - time before vear 0 on the calendar

Bronze

a metal alloy of copper and tin

Dwelling

a place where a person lives; home; house

chasing wild animals for the purpose of capturing or killing them, usually for food

Iron

a metal

Knapping

to break or chip (stone) with sharp blows,

Nomadic

a life with no fixed home, just moving from place to place

Prehistory

before written history

Tool

Axe - a tool with a blade attached to the end of a long handle.



Hand axe - a tool with sharp edges

Sword - a pointed weapon with one or two sharp edges and a handle



Knife - a tool with a handle and a thin, sharp blade, used for cutting.
