## English



Children will continue to have daily RWI Phonics lessons, as we prepare for the Phonics Screening Test. In our writing lessons, we will be reading and immersing ourselves in the following texts: *Paddington's post, Here comes Mr Postmouse, Click, clack Moo, cows that type, Out and about: First book of poems, Little Red and the hungry lion and many more.*

## Maths
